

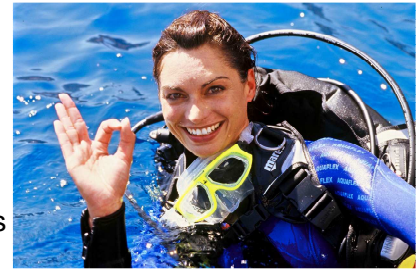


## PADI Divemaster

The training and experience you gain through the PADI Dive Master program helps to shape your abilities and attitude toward becoming a professional level Diving Educator. To help shape you into a Dive Professional, PADI has developed the Dive Master Crew Pack and various other material.

**Becoming a PADI Dive Master denotes you as a person who:**

- Has a high level of personal diving skill
- Has Instructor level knowledge of diving theory
- Has had significant training in how to assist an instructor during training activities and is able to assume appropriate responsibilities that benefit the welfare of other divers



**As a PADI Dive Master you will be qualified to:**

- Conduct and supervise recreational dives both land & boat based
- Assist PADI Instructors in conducting PADI Diver programs
- You will be required to complete 3 phases; Practical Application; Knowledge Development; Waterman-ship/Skills Assessment
- Upon successfully completing the PADI Dive Master program, you will receive a certification card and wall certificate denoting this rating. You will also become a member of PADI

# PADI Divemaster

- Supervise both training and non-training-related activities by planning, organizing and directing dives
- Assist a [PADI Instructor](#) during the training sessions for any PADI Diver course
- Conduct the PADI Skin Diver course and PADI Discover Snorkeling program
- Conduct the PADI Discover Local Diving experience
- Conduct the PADI [Scuba Review](#) program
- If qualified as a Discover Scuba Diving Leader, independently conduct the PADI [Discover Scuba Diving](#) program.

### Prerequisites

- You will need to be a certified PADI Advanced Openwater Diver
- You will need to be a certified PADI Rescue Diver
- You will have logged a minimum of 20 Open Water dives prior to entry into PADI Divemaster training and completed and logged a minimum of 60 Openwater dives with experience in night, deep and navigation to Certification as a PADI Dive Master
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be in good physical condition for diving and submit a medical examination signed by a Physician
