- This course has several additional topics such as orientation to academic teaching, orientation to confined open water teaching, orientation to open water teaching, water skills and a program orientation to outline all activities and requirements.



To qualify for the Instructor Development program, you must:

- Be Certified as a PADI Dive Master or Assistant Instructor.
- Provide a current diving medical (dated within the last 12 months) in accordance with AS 4005.1
