



PADI Dry Suit Diver Course

Water may cover 70% of the earth's surface, but if it wasn't for exposure suits, diving would be limited to a relatively narrow band straddling the equator. That would indeed be a pity as some of the best diving lies well north and south of tropical waters. Without protection from the cold, some of the best diving would be inaccessible.

Of the exposure suit types available, the modern dry suit has opened the door to comfortable diving in the coolest water - adding a dry suit to your equipment adds to the number of dive sites you can visit and extends the dive season into the cooler months.

This course covers

- The knowledge and techniques of dry suit diving safely.
- Planning, organizing, procedures, techniques and possible hazards of dry suit diving.
- During the confined water session and 2 ocean dives, we will get you really comfortable in the dry suit and look at proper buoyancy control as well as descent techniques.
- This course also covers routine, user-level, preventative maintenance and performance checks on dry suits. This is a very practical course with no theory exam!
- Undergarment (fleece or overall-type garments worn under the dry suit) options
- How to pack a dry suit to prevent damage
