



TDI Intro to Tech Diver

(Technical Diving Skills and Planning to 26msw No Deco)

This course introduces the students to the world of technical diving. The object is to familiarise divers with technical gear configurations, to enhance open water diving skills and advanced gas planning in a no decompression context to a maximum depth of 26msw.

STUDENT PRE-REQUISITES

- Minimum age of 18, minimum of 25 logged dives and certification as an
- Advanced Adventure (Advanced Open Water) Diver or equivalent.

REQUIRED COURSE MINIMUMS

- Classroom / Briefing Hours - 6
- Openwater Dives - 3

Physics, Physiology, Equipment Considerations, Dive Planning, Technical Diving Procedures, Open Water Skills, Land Drills, In-Water Drills

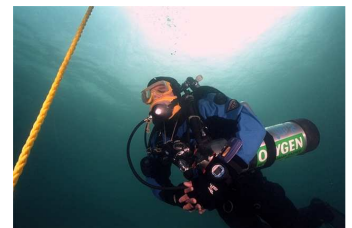
